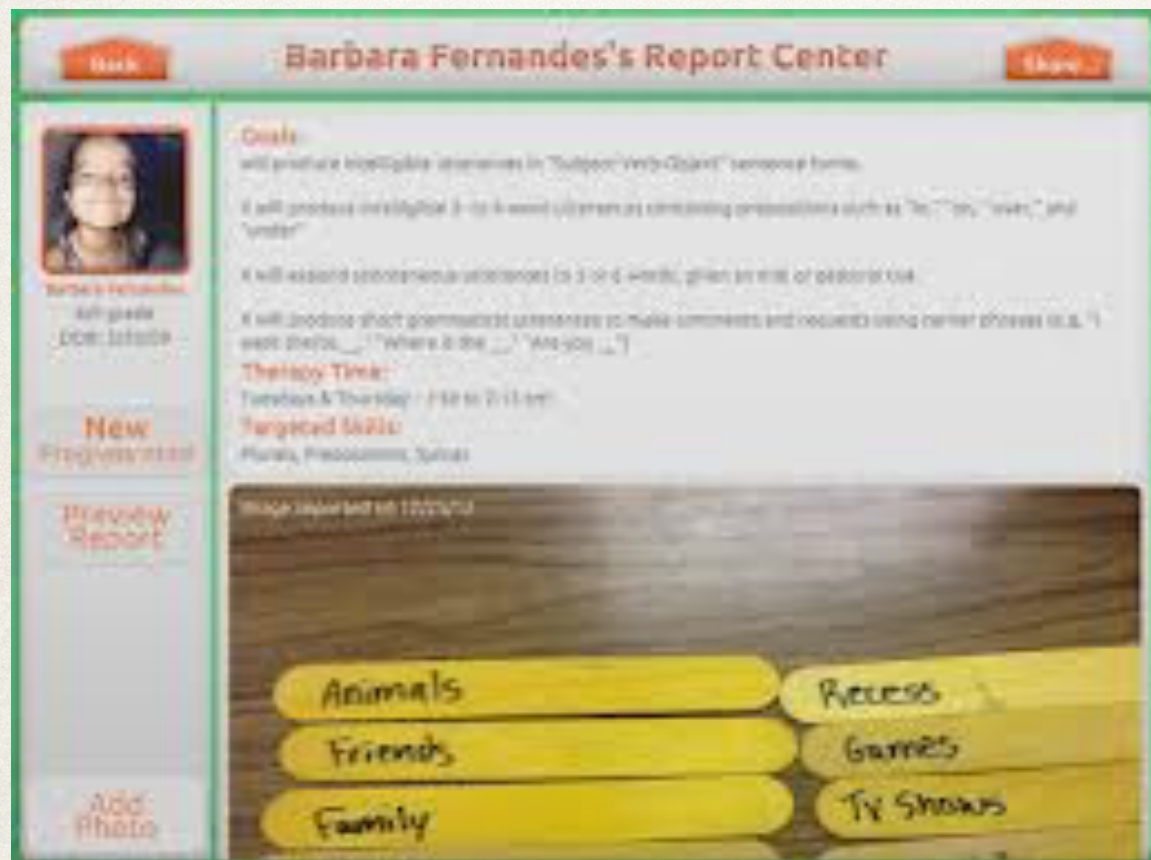
We did a craft! It was so much fun, we worked on vocabulary, following directions, and whquestions.


A reward center allows clinicians to set goals and track progress of those goals.
